Donor Privacy Policy

The Chronic Wellness Collective (“CWC”) values each of its donors and takes their privacy very seriously. To that end, we maintain the highest level of confidentiality concerning our donors' contact and financial information. All online and offline donor transactions with CWC are covered by this policy and are conducted over secure portals. Access to this data is password-protected and limited to authorized CWC employees.

What We Collect

CWC collects the following personal information from our donors: donor name, acknowledgement name, amount donated, address, telephone number, and email address.

How We Use Donor Information

Donor information is used for internal purposes only. CWC does not sell or lease donor information. Donor information will only be used by CWC's staff to:

- Distribute receipts for donations;
- Thank donors for their contribution;
- Inform donors about current and upcoming activities, including additional opportunities to support PoP;
- Track and analyze donor data;
- Comply with current rules and regulations governing IRC 501(c)(3) financial reporting; and
- Comply with any reporting requirements related to specific grants or contributions.

Donor's Bill of Rights

1. To be informed of CWC's mission, of the way CWC intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for its intended purposes.
2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on CWC's Board of Directors and to expect the Board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
3. To have access to CWC's most recent financial statements.
4. To be assured their gifts will be used by CWC for the purposes for which they were given.
5. To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition of all contributions to CWC.
6. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
7. To be assured that their contact information will not be used if so chosen by the donor.
8. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization or hired solicitors.
9. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
